Students must be present every morning at 8.20am for roll call.

Base rooms for Core subjects: 3A – Room 102, 3D – Room 103, 3I – Room 105, 3L – Room 107, 3R – Room 114, 3G – Class split in half between Rooms 103 and 114. (Same people in each room as it was for the Xmas Exams.)

For Option Subjects – Go to the room listed on the sheet on the white board/base room door as normal.

Go to the canteen in between exams to get a bite to eat/study before the next exam.

If you have finished exams for the day after the morning exam, you may go home.

You must have all your own materials for the exams, pens, pencils, colouring pencils, ruler, pencil sharpener, rubber, calculator etc. You may not borrow equipment from other students during the exam. Paper will be provided and can be requested from the supervisor.

If you communicate or attempt to communicate with another student during the exam, your exam will be cancelled, as is the case in the state exams.

Students are permitted to use the bathroom during break times and study times. Students are not permitted to use the bathroom during an exam.

You must remain in the exam centre until the exam duration is complete. If you finish an exam early, use the time wisely, read back over and check your answers and add more detail and description to answers. Try your very best to ensure you reach your full potential.
